



Recreational Experiences Close to Home!

Realizing that a trained dog is a valuable asset, the CGCCB allows year-around dog training at designated locations on portions of 3 of its 30 areas. The remaining areas are subject to the following regulation:

“The training of Dogs shall not be allowed on any area between the dates of March 15 through July 15, except the area on Mike Zack Wildlife area west of the railroad right-of-way and the South Greenbelt on the west side of the Shell Rock River and at the south end of Quarry Lake (water training only) at the Lime Creek Conservation Area.”

In addition to the above rule, the Lime Creek Conservation Area, Wilkinson Park, Linn Grove Park, Ingebretson Park and Strand Park require all dogs to be on a 6-foot leash.

As noted in the above rule the year-around training of dogs is permitted at the Mike Zack Wildlife area and the South Greenbelt. The designated area at Mike Zack is the area on west side of the railroad right-of-way, also known as Fin and Feather Lake. The designated area at the South Greenbelt is located from inside the south entrance to the first creek crossing north of the entrance, and extending from the river west to the boundary fence. The south end of Quarry Lake (water training only) at the Lime Creek Conservation Area. See maps on back for locations.

Mike Zack Wildlife Area is located at 16638 230th St. To get there go 1 ½ miles south of Mason City on Hwy. 65 and then turn east on 230th St. and go ½ mile.

The **South Greenbelt** is located just north of County Road B30, 4 ½ miles east of Mason City.

Lime Creek Conservation Area is located just off of Hwy. 65 north of Mason City.

State regulations involving vaccinations, training and pen-raised birds also apply to county areas. Check the latest copy of the Iowa Hunting, Fishing
