Maximum dimensions allowed and travel restrictions on an annual oversize permit are:

- 120' long x 12'5" wide x 13'10" high – unlimited distance – no routing required.
- 120' long x 14'6" wide x 15'5" high – movement restricted to 50 mile radius.
- 120' long x 16' wide x 15'5" high – trip routes must be obtained.
- 75' long x 12'5" wide x 14'6" high – maximum dimensions for hauling hay

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Mover shall maintain, consistent with the safety of the traveling public, that speed specified by this permit.

Mover shall take steps necessary to avoid and reduce traffic congestion by maintaining proper traffic interval, temporarily relinquishing the traveled way in order to provide a passing opportunity for the following vehicles desiring to travel faster than the prescribed speed of the permit vehicle. This should be done as soon as conveniently possible after a group of two or more vehicles accumulated in back of the permit vehicle.

Mover shall notify the issuing authority(ies) in writing of the fact of the occurrence of any reportable motor vehicle accident involving any permit vehicle.

The issuing authorities assume no responsibility for property of applicant by issuance of this permit.

Mover shall comply with terms and conditions of the permit, take all reasonable precautions to protect and safeguard lives and property of traveling public and adjacent property owners, and shall hold the issuing authority(ies) harmless of any damages that may be sustained on account of such move.

Mover shall hold the issuing authority(ies) harmless for any damages that may result to secondary roads by movement made hereunder and shall reimburse the issuing authority(ies) for any expenditure which the issuing authority(ies) may have to make on account of such move.

Nothing in permit shall be construed as waiving any load limitations which have been or which might be established on any bridge or any road posted with embargo signs.

Permit and any supplements or additions thereto shall be void in case the weights or dimensions of the vehicle and load as operated exceed the weights or dimensions as provided in the permit and supplements or additions thereto.

No vehicle or combination of vehicles of illegal dimensions with or without load shall be moved on Iowa roads without permit.

Permit is valid only for the transporting of a single article per move exceeding statutory size or weight limits or both, and which cannot reasonably be divided, or reduced to statutory size and weight limits except in the transportation of property consisting of more than one article exceeding the statutory size limits when the statutory weight limitations are not exceeded and the additional articles transported do not exceed statutory size in any way in which such limits would not be exceeded by the single article.

Permit shall be carried in cab of vehicle for which permit is issued and shall be available for inspection at all times. Vehicles for which permit is issued shall be open to inspection by any peace officer or any authorized agent of any permit granting authority.

Movements under permit shall be made only during daylight hours unless it is established by the issuing authority that movement can be better accomplished at another period of time because of traffic volume conditions. Except as provided in Section 321.457 of the Code, no movement of over-dimension vehicles shall be permitted on Saturdays, Sundays, Holidays, or days preceding or following holidays, or special events when abnormally high traffic volumes can be expected.

Permit not valid on primary roads or within corporate limits of any municipality.

Mover shall furnish such escorts as may be required by Statute.
