

Mason City Area Veterans Monument



For use after 1 July 2019

On November 11, 2004 a new monument to honor our Veterans was dedicated in Central Park by the Mason City Veterans Memorial Association.

Any Veteran that has a tie to Mason City, completed their military obligation with an honorable discharge is eligible to have their name placed on the monument.

A minimum contribution of \$150.00, along with the completed application, and copy of proof of discharge is needed in order to place the Veteran's name on the monument.

Proof of discharge can be a copy of the Veteran's DD214 or Certificate of Discharge.

No contribution is necessary for any Veteran Killed in Action or Missing in Action.

The monument consists of 12 black granite stones, with room for 4,600 names. Names shall be continuously accepted for inclusion on the monument. Names received prior to June 30th. of each year will be inscribed prior to Veterans Day (November 11). Names received after June 30th. will be inscribed on the monument the next year. The best time of year to submit an application is from April thru June.
