



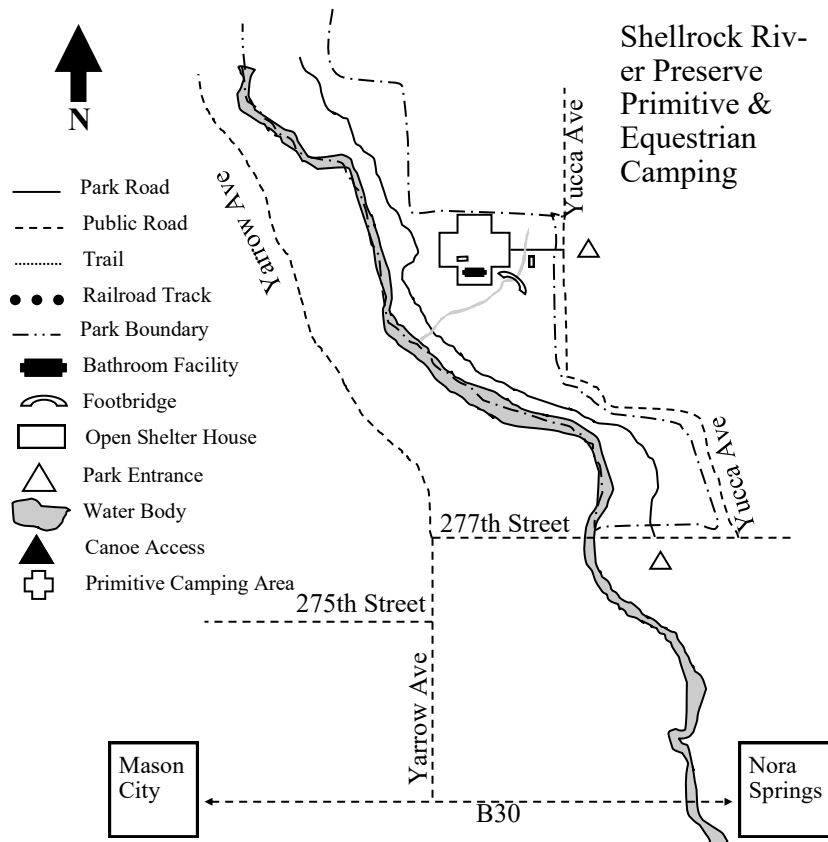

# Recreational Experiences Close to Home!

The Lime Creek Conservation Area (LCCA) provides two sites for primitive camping.

- Campers must register and the cost is \$5.00/night (1 tent with 1 bundle of firewood).
- Permits available M-F at the LCNC, and not accepted past 3:30 p.m. on the same day of the requested camping permit outing.
- Camping permit and vehicle permit are required to camp at a LCCA primitive campsite.
- Camping group must have one member (permit holder) 18 years or over in charge.
- Only registered camping group (w/camping permit) is permitted in area after 10:30 p.m.
- Only registered vehicle(s) (with vehicle permit) is permitted in LCNC parking lot overnight. (Only overnight parking lot).
- Quiet hours will be observed from 10:30 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- No firewood cutting allowed.
- Fires are authorized only in the provided metal fire ring/grill. All fires must be extinguished prior to leaving.
- All garbage and litter must be removed (carry in/carry out policy).
- All CGCCB rules and regulations apply.

**Site A (Campsite #1)**- located on the Brewery Loop and is approximately 0.36 miles from the parking lot.

**Site B (Campsite #2)**- located on the Old Stage Run and is approximately 0.71 miles from the parking lot.
