



Recreational Experiences Close to Home!

Kuhn Wildlife Area-located on 310th ¼ mile west of Balsam. (1873-310th St.)

Located along the Winnebago River. One-half mile of river frontage is accessible. Common fish species present are Northern Pike, Channel Catfish, Black Bullhead, White Sucker, Yellow Bullhead, Common Carp, Redhorse.

Winnebago Oxbow-loc. 1 mile no. of the intersection of blacktop B-20 & Cardinal Ave. (3100-320th St.)

Located along the Winnebago River. One-quarter mile of river frontage is accessible. Common fish species present are Northern Pike, Channel Catfish, Black Bullhead, White Sucker, Yellow Bullhead, Common Carp, Redhorse.

Kingfisher Hollow Access-located 2 miles north of blacktop B-20 on Jonquil Ave and 1/4 mile east on Wheelerwood Road (10250 Wheelerwood Dr.)

Located along the Winnebago River. One-quarter mile of river frontage is accessible. Common fish species present are Northern Pike, Channel Catfish, Black Bullhead, White Sucker, Yellow Bullhead, Common Carp, Redhorse, Smallmouth Bass, Walleye.

Lime Creek Conservation Area-located off U.S. Hwy 65 north of Mason City (3501 Lime Creek Rd.)

Located along the Winnebago River. Two and one-half miles of river frontage is accessible. Common fish species present are Northern Pike, Channel Catfish, Black Bullhead, White Sucker, Yellow Bullhead, Common Carp, Redhorse, Smallmouth Bass, Walleye.

Spring Creek Preserve-located 1/4 mile east of U.S. Highway 65 on blacktop B-20 (15829 300th St.)

Located along the Winnebago River. One-half mile of river frontage is accessible. Common fish species present are Northern Pike, Channel Catfish, Black Bullhead, White Sucker, Yellow Bullhead, Common Carp, Redhorse, Smallmouth Bass, Walleye.

Averydale Access-located just south of U.S. Highway 122 on Birch Dr

Located along the Winnebago River. One-eighth mile of river frontage is accessible. Common fish species present are Northern Pike, Channel Catfish, Black Bullhead, White Sucker, Yellow Bullhead, Common Carp, Redhorse, Smallmouth Bass, Walleye.

Goranson Access-located just south of U.S. Highway 122 on Birch Dr (3139 Birch Dr.)

Located along the Winnebago River. One-quarter mile of river frontage is accessible. Common fish species present are Northern Pike, Channel Catfish, Black Bullhead, White Sucker, Yellow Bullhead, Common Carp, Redhorse, Smallmouth Bass, Walleye.

Claybanks Forest-Two tracts of land: one 5 miles south of Nora Springs on blacktop S-70 and 3 miles west on 225th St; another 1/2 mile east (from first site) and 1/2 mile north on Wren Ave (22924-225th St.)

Located along the Winnebago River. Three-quarter miles of river frontage is accessible. Common fish species present are Northern Pike, Channel Catfish, Black Bullhead, White Sucker, Yellow Bullhead, Common Carp, Redhorse, Smallmouth Bass, Walleye.

Strand Park-located southeast of the intersection of blacktop S-56 and 340th St, just north of Plymouth (20057-340th St.)

Located along the Shell Rock River. One-half mile of river frontage is accessible. Common fish species present are Channel Catfish, Smallmouth Bass, Northern Pike, Walleye, White Sucker, Common Carp, Redhorse.

Wilkinson Pioneer Park-located at the end of blacktop B-20 in Rock Falls (21425 Vine Ave.)

Located along the Shell Rock River. One and one-quarter mile of river frontage is accessible. Common fish species present are Channel Catfish, Smallmouth Bass, Northern Pike, Walleye, White Sucker, Common Carp, Redhorse.

Shell Rock River Greenbelt-accessible from 295th St south of Wilkinson Pioneer Park and Highway 122 west of Nora Springs

Located along the Shell Rock River. Four and one-half mile of river frontage is accessible. Common fish species present are Channel Catfish, Smallmouth Bass, Northern Pike, Walleye, White Sucker, Common Carp, Redhorse.

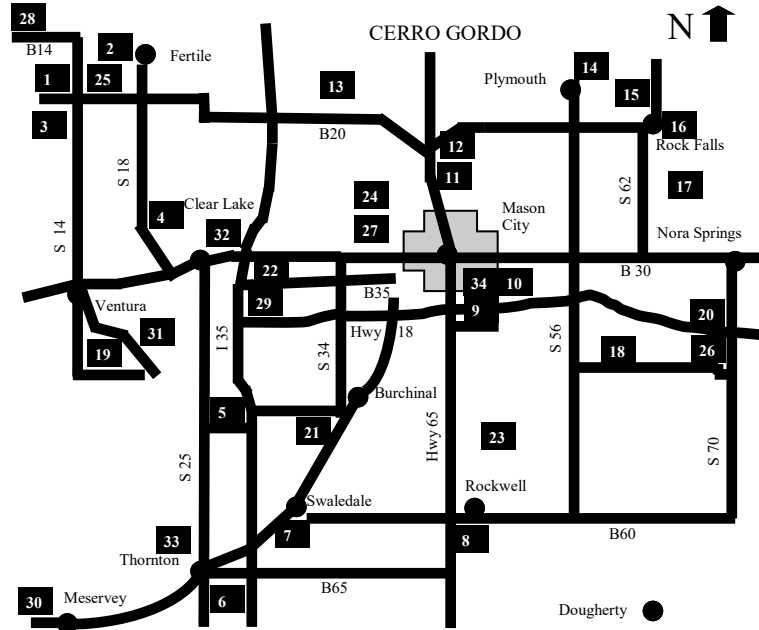
